

PowerPoint Book Talk-Fiction

Due Date: Monday, September 26, 2016

You will create a PowerPoint presentation for a book that you have read this school year. It must be a book that is within your AR level. Each slide needs to contain the required elements. Presentations should be no less than 3 minutes and no longer than 7 minutes. Rehearse your presentation to remain within the guidelines for time. You will receive a separate rubric for the presentation. This project will be calculated into the Reading and Listening/Speaking grades.

Tips:

- Create your power point from the template on my website
- Come before or after school on Tuesday, September 13, and/or Thursday, September 15 for help from Mrs. Hight-Room B5 (7:45-8:10 or 2:50-3:15)
- Save your power point and bring to school on a flash drive.

Slide Layout:

- Slide 1: Title page- Title of book, author's name, your name, and picture (8 pts.)
- Slide 2: Summary- 5-8 sentence summary of the story (paragraph format) (10 pts.)
- Slide 3: Setting-Explain the where and when, and provide a picture (8 pts.)
- Slide 4: Main Character(s)-Describe the main character(s) (physical and character traits) (8 pts.)
- Slide 5: Vocabulary/Sentences- 5 Vocabulary words with definitions and 3 sentences from the story (i.e., dialogue, alliteration, simile, metaphor, or any other figurative language) (10 pts.)
- Slide 6: About the Author- Give interesting information about the author and list other books by the same author (10 pts.)
- Slide 7: Connections- This is where you will tell about the connections you have made to the text. These can be text-to-self, text-to-text, and/or text-to-world. (6 pts.)
- Slide 8: Book Review/Recommendation- Tell whether you would recommend this book to your classmates and why. Give information about the genre, AR level, and what kind of reader would enjoy this story. (10 pts.)

Reading Project Grade Total: 75 points (This is a long-term assignment, and per CTA policy, 50% is the highest grade that will be given for late assignments.)
