Fred Mann

Position: Head Coach

Experience at Perry: 1st year with women's team

Perry High School is excited to welcome Fred Mann as the new head girls varsity volleyball coach effective for the 2013-14 season. Coach Mann is coming to Perry from Mountain Pointe High School, where he led the boys and girls teams to a combined eight state championships. He will also serve as a guidance counselor overseeing the STEM program at Perry HS.

Mann led the Pride boys to state titles in 1995, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2008 and 2009, and the girls to the 2001 championship. In addition, the Mountain Pointe teams combined for three state runner-up seasons.

Born and raised in South Africa, Mann served a two-year mandatory military service in the Parachute Battalion and went on to play as an outside hitter in college for a national championship team. He then moved to the U.S. in 1991 at age 25 where he continued to play professional beach volleyball from 1990 until 1995. Mann and his wife, Angie, have three children, Levi (age 18), Kaylee (15) and Morgan (11).



Brian Pomerantz

Position: JV Coach

Experience at Perry: 1st year with women's team, 4th year with men's team

Brian Pomerantz is a native of Columbus, Ohio. 2013-14 marks first year as JV women's coach and third year as head men's coach at Perry. His 2013 men's team finished in fifth place in AIA state tournament. Coach Pomerantz began coaching collegiately in 1999 and has worked with Miami University, University at Albany, Dublin Scioto and Upper Arlington High Schools, and Borderline, Vanguard and East Valley Juniors (former Arizona Primitive) volleyball clubs.

In his past three seasons as a head coach, Pomerantz has helped 9 players in receiving offers to play NCAA volleyball. Coach Pomerantz is very excited to begin the process of helping the 2014 women's team achieve their own goals.

Coach Pomerantz played volleyball for Upper Arlington High School, Miami University and the University at Albany clubs. He was named captain at Arlington, Miami and Albany. His degrees are in Zoology (BA, Miami, 02) and Political Science (MA Albany, 03). He lives in Phoenix with his, Nicole.

Position: Freshman Coach

Charlea Hillman is in her first year as Freshman Coach at Perry High School. She began her volleyball career in 2000 while attending Mountain Pointe High School in Phoenix, Arizona, where she was a part of the 2003 Central All-Region team and the 2004 State Runner-up team.

Charlea continued her volleyball career after receiving a scholarship to play for Pat Mooney at South Mountain Community College. As a Cougar, she played as an outside hitter and opposite. She was honored as an Academic All-American in 2009.

In 2011, she was named as the Assistant Coach for the Arizona Region Select High Performance team which went on to win the bronze medal at the USA Volleyball High Performance Championships in Tucson.

Charlea has worked with several volleyball clubs, most recently Spiral and spent a season as Freshman coach Chandler High School. Currently, she is studying Exercise and Wellness at Arizona State.
