RULES & POLICIES

Date and time: May 28, 2014 10:45pm Check-in at PHS Midnight-5am Dave & Busters then transported back to PHS by bus

To ensure the safety of all attendees, and to protect the facility, all PHS school rules will be observed and enforced, including dress code and the code of conduct. Strict (but fair and reasonable) rules and regulations established in the past have worked well and kept our graduates safe. We will be using these same rules in cooperation with the security and/or Police Department of our event site. Grad Night 2014 information and rules are as follows:

- 1. Only eligible graduates of Perry High School Class of 2014 may attendno guests. No refunds if a student becomes ineligible or if a student is unable to attend. Photo ID is required at check-in.
- 2. All students (including those 18 years old or older) must have the Consent and Release Form completed and signed by a parent or guardian to attend the event. If your emergency or contact information changes, please send an email to hollibobbymcmahon@gmail.com prior to event. Additional forms available in athletics office.
- 3. Arrive promptly for check-in at PHS main gym. If a graduate has purchased a ticket, and has not arrived by 11:00pm, parents will be notified at that time at the phone number provided in the Consent and Release Form.
- 4. No graduate will be permitted to leave early for safety reasons. We strongly recommend that a designated adult pick up the graduates from PHS. They will be very tired and driving may be unsafe.
- 5. Attire is INFORMAL and within school dress code. Comfortable dress suggestion would be athletic shoes, shorts/sweats, active wear and sweatshirt/jacket.
- 7. No bottles, cans or thermoses may be brought in to GRAD night 2014. Students may be subject to a Breathalyzer test. Anyone arriving intoxicated, under the influence of drugs or acting in a disorderly manner

will be referred to the security officer on duty and will not be allowed to attend the event. Anyone found by chaperones to be drinking, using drugs or acting disorderly will be referred to the security officer on duty.

- 8. No food may be brought in to GRAD night 2014. A variety of food and beverages will be provided throughout the evening.
- 9. Only medications properly listed on the Consent and Release Form will be allowed. Any medication not properly listed will be confiscated, including Aspirin, Tylenol, Advil and the like.
- 10. Smoking is not permitted. All tobacco products, lighters and matches will be confiscated.

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

This event will observe a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY. All backpacks, purses and bags will be thoroughly searched. Light pat downs may be necessary and conducted in the presence of at least 2 chaperones or security personnel. The following items are not allowed and will be confiscated:

Any alcohol and/or drugs, including marijuana: If a graduate is in possession of, or is suspected to be under the influence of, alcohol or drugs, his/her parent or guardian will be called and be required to pick him/her up. The proper authority may be called where required by law. No refund will be given.

NO Weapons: This includes all sharp objects such as nail files, scissors, knives, etc.

Any serious infraction of the rules of Grad Night 2014 will be reported to the parent/guardian by telephone and may result in removal from the event. If the parent/guardian cannot be reached, the graduate in question will be considered to be in the custody of the security and /or police.
