Student Packing List



Here's what you'll need to bring to camp:

- Sack lunch for the first day
- Sleeping bag or bedding for twin bed (sheets & blankets) packed in large garbage bag with your name written on duck tape.
- Pillow
- Warm night clothes and slippers
- 2 pairs of jeans/pants
- 2 shirts
- Jackets or sweaters for layering on very cold mornings and evenings
- Comfortable shoes for hiking (if not waterproof, bring 2 pairs if possible). Must have closed toe and heel.
- 3-4 pairs of warm non-cotton socks
- Gloves
- Hat
- 2 changes of underwear
- Rain gear

Whatever shall I wear?

You should plan on being outside for most of the time that you are at camp, so think about how to stay warm and dry when it's cold and wet. Here's some tips on how to do that:

- The weather can be unpredictable, so you need to be ready for anything. Bring lots of layers and pile them on to stay warm in the morning, then shed them later when it warms up.
- Non-cotton clothing is warmer when wet than cotton is. Try to wear wool or synthetic fibers closest to your skin.
- If you don't have wool socks, wear nylon dress socks under your cotton socks. The nylon will keep your feet dry and warmer.
- A warm hat can help almost as much as another layer (and it hides the bed-head you woke up with).

- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Towel, washcloth, soap and shampoo (in a Ziploc bag)
- Brush/comb
- Deodorant
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight and batteries
- Canteen or water bottle
- Chapstick

You can also bring:

- Disposable camera
- Day pack
- Good book
- Card games for the cabin
