

## HOW TO EMBED A YOUTUBE VIDEO INTO A SCHOOLWIRES PAGE

Don't just link to a YouTube web address! If you EMBED a YouTube video's embed code instead, you can turn off "related videos" at the end... which are NOT always appropriate for students! Here's how to do it:

### 1. GET THE YOUTUBE EMBED CODE

In YouTube, beneath the video, click on **Share** > **Embed** > **Show More**. Make sure the **Video Size** starts with **640** and change it to "640" if it doesn't.


#### Why do this?

The video will *look better* on your webpage if you make sure that the video is *wide* enough: 640 (wide) is a **good** size and will fit best on your page.

### IMPORTANT!

Make sure "Show suggested videos when the video finishes" is **UNCHECKED**! (If you leave it *checked*, it's like a box of chocolates: "You never know what you're going to get...." And it could display previews of videos that are **INAPPROPRIATE** for students.)

Select the embed code ("`<iframe width=...`" etc.) from the box and **copy** it.



### 2. PASTE THE EMBED CODE INTO YOUR SCHOOLWIRES PAGE:

Click the **New Page** button to create a new page in your Schoolwires section as you normally do... > ...but select **Embed Code** as the page type. (FYI: Page types are listed in *alphabetical order*... so, scroll down to see it if needed.) **Paste** the YouTube Embed Code you copied earlier into it your new page and click **Save**. **DONE!**

**NOTE** that students can't access YouTube using district computers.
