1	Resident transfer students who currently attend the school and their siblings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>John lives in the Conley boundary, attended Tarwater last year and will be returning.</i></li> <li>• <i>John's sister will be entering kindergarten next year.</i></li> </ul>
2	1Children of employees and previously accepted and enrolled non-resident students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Simon works at Bogle Jr. High and he will request a boundary exemption for his children to attend Tarwater.</i></li> <li>• <i>Randy lives in the Kyrene School District boundaries and attended Tarwater last year and will be returning.</i></li> </ul>
3	Resident transfer students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Karen lives in the Jacobson boundary and will request a boundary exemption to attend Tarwater.</i></li> </ul>
4	Previously accepted and enrolled non-resident students' siblings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Tim lives in the Kyrene School District boundaries and attends Tarwater (Priority Group 2). His brother, Joe will be entering Kindergarten next year and requesting a boundary exemption to attend Tarwater.</i></li> </ul>
5	Non-resident students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Gary lives in the Kyrene School District boundaries and will submit a boundary exemption to attend Tarwater next year.</i></li> </ul>
