## Kids Express "Paradise Island" Summer Camp 2013 Registration Instructions and Cancellation Policy



On-line registration is now available! If your child is not yet enrolled in Kids Express, you will need to complete the enrollment process first at <a href="https://www.cusdcommunity.com">www.cusdcommunity.com</a>. Read and follow the on-screen instructions and call 480-224-3915 for assistance, if necessary. Account balances must be current to register for camp.

### For best results, please observe the following:

- 1) Please read <u>all</u> camp information, instructions, camp itineraries, and other documents provided so you are fully informed of schedules, due dates, policies, deadlines, parent tips, lunch options, and "arrive-by" times for excursion days.
- 2) Check to see that your Community Education account is current prior to registering for camp.
- 3) Determine your childcare needs for the summer.
- 4) When logged into your online account, click the Kids Express Summer Camp 2013 registration link in the "News & Info" area on the left.
- 5) Select the appropriate camp location using your child's home school instructions on the front of this flyer.
- 6) Select the days of care needed. You may register and pay for individual days or a week or two at a time. However, <u>please be aware that each site has a specific daily capacity</u>, so reserving and paying for days far enough in advance is the best way to ensure your child's space.

  There is a discount if all camp days are selected and paid for in one transaction. However,
- 7) Charges for reserved days are due immediately via debit or credit card on the account. Unpaid reservations will not be saved.
- 8) If check or money-order payments have been authorized on your account, bring or mail to the CUSD Community Education Registration & Accounting Office at 1525 W. Frye Rd., Chandler AZ 85224 within 3 business days.
- 9) There are no refunds for unused days.

To receive the full Summer discount you must contact the Accounting Office at 480-224-3922 and it will be manually applied. Discounts are non-cumulative.



### \*\*CANCELLATION POLICY\*\*

The deadline to receive full credit for cancellations of camp registration is Wednesday, May 29th, 2013. Any cancellations submitted after this date will receive 50% credit towards future care. The other 50% is forfeited. There are no credits or refunds issued for unused camp days. No other credits or refunds will be authorized.

### CUSD - Kids Express & 'Tween Zone 2013 SUMMER CAMP TIPS FOR PARENTS



Thank you for choosing Kids Express and/or 'Tween Zone for your summer camp needs. After much planning and preparation, we are looking forward to getting summer camp underway. Please plan on signing your child in each day and provide photo I.D. before signing out. Signatures must be legible and include at least the first initial and full last name. 'Tween Zone campers may sign themselves in/out if parents prefer. For your convenience, we have put together this list of tips and suggestions designed to make your child's summer camp experience as fun and enjoyable as possible. Please pay special attention to information regarding field trip days, as this will help you and your child prepare.

### **Important Notice:**

**CTA-Independence Camp Site:** Please be aware that the dates for this camp site are June 3<sup>rd</sup> through June 28<sup>th</sup>. There will be only one field trip, June 27<sup>th</sup>, to the Circus. In coordination with Elementary Summer Academy courses being offered at this site from June 5<sup>th</sup> to June 26<sup>th</sup>, we will be staying on campus and enjoying fun and engaging on-site activities and special attraction days. Students attending both Summer Academy classes and Kids Express Summer Camp will be assisted with any necessary transitions to and from classes. This site will close after June 28<sup>th</sup> but our other Kids Express and Tween Zone camp sites will all be open through July 19th.

Andersen, Basha, Carlson, and Tarwater Sites: Please be aware that, with the exception of swim days, <u>all</u> students and <u>all</u> staff attend the field trips on field trip days. On swim days, alternate activities are provided for non-swimmers. However, the rate for the day does not change if the parent chooses not to have their child participate in swimming. Summer Academy students taking advantage of bussing to/from their campsite will be escorted to and from the bus loop area.

### **Everyday**:

We strongly encourage you to apply sunscreen each morning before arriving at camp. Your child may bring sunscreen to camp **as long as their first and last names are on the bottle.** If it is left at the site, we will need to keep it in an area away from free access by children. Staff will have spray sunscreen available if needed. Also, please encourage your child to dress appropriately for the weather and temperatures. Something cool and loose should be fine most days, but should provide adequate and discreet coverage. We recommend sneakers or tennis shoes, as flip-flops will not protect the feet or toes during active play. Flip-flops may be brought to wear during all swim trips or water activities. Label all belongings. Kids Express is not responsible for lost or stolen electronics, or any other items brought from home. Please check the camp lost and found area often for items your child may have left behind.

### **Snacks and FREE Breakfast and Lunch:**

This year, CUSD Nutrition Services will again provide daily delicious and nutritious hot and cold breakfast and lunch choices AT NO CHARGE to ALL participants ALL SUMMER LONG! The menu is available on our website, <a href="www.cusdcommunity.com">www.cusdcommunity.com</a>, or from the parent table at each site. Breakfast is optional based on whether your child is hungry at serving time or not. However, <a href="figure-16">if you do not wish to select from the daily lunch menu choices, your child MUST bring a non-perishable packed lunch from home, labeled with his/her name.</code>

**Please Note:** Many children who attend our camps live with life-threatening allergies to nuts and nut products, so care and caution are used to keep them safe by keeping items that contain, or may contain, nuts or nut oil to a minimum. Kids Express does provide "Peanut-Free" tables at our camps in an effort to protect against exposure. Any child can sit at the peanut-free table as long as their lunch does not contain a peanut product. <u>Please DO NOT bring lunches that require heating.</u> Afternoon snacks are included in the daily rate and the snack menu is posted daily near the parent table at each site.

### On-Site Days:

Activities for on-site days include our "Club Street" activities and S.T.E.M. projects, indoor and outdoor organized sports, open activity centers, Wii™/XBox™ challenges, karaoke, art and craft projects, large and small group games, movies, special treats, and much more!

### Field Trip Days

Each site (except Independence) has two field trips or special attraction days most weeks. Please refer to the June and July Activity Calendars for the scheduled destinations and "Arrive By" times assigned to the site your child is attending. Please arrive at camp with your child by the designated time to avoid missing the bus. In order to participate in the field trips, you will need to enter your child's name and your signature onto the appropriate permission form. Each child will receive a camp T-shirt to wear on field trip days. Extra spending money is optional. Socks may be required for some field trips, so watch for reminders to be posted at the sites.

### \*Swim Days:

Our swim trips are scheduled every other week. If participating, your child will need a swimsuit, a change of clothes, and a towel. Water shoes are optional. We will provide one small water bottle to each child and a string backpack for use on swim days. Please apply sunscreen before coming to camp. Sunscreen may be brought to camp to re-apply as long as the child's name is written on the bottle. We will store the bottles before and after the trip. If you prefer your child not attend the swimming trips, there will be alternate activities at each site.

### \*Movie Days:

Children will be transported to Harkins – Chandler Crossroads or Arizona Mills on their movie days. A "Kid Pack", which includes popcorn and a drink, is covered with the tuition for the day. No additional spending money is necessary. Other movies may be shown onsite during which we may offer an ice cream, snow cone, popcorn, or cotton candy treat.

### Water Days:

There may be water-fun days periodically throughout the weeks of summer camp. Each site will post the chosen days and your child will need a towel and a change of clothes or swimsuit so they can get wet.
