The proposed \$196 million bond proceeds would fund:

- Construction, acquisition, additions and/or improvements to new and existing schools \$81.5 million
- Building renovations, security or site improvements to existing schools -- \$53.8 million
- Heating, ventilation, and air condition -- \$15 million
- Furniture, equipment, school furnishings, buses, and technology (computers, wireless, etc)
- -- \$39 million
- Renovations to support facilities -- \$4.7 million
- Technology, furniture and equipment for support facilities -- \$2 million
