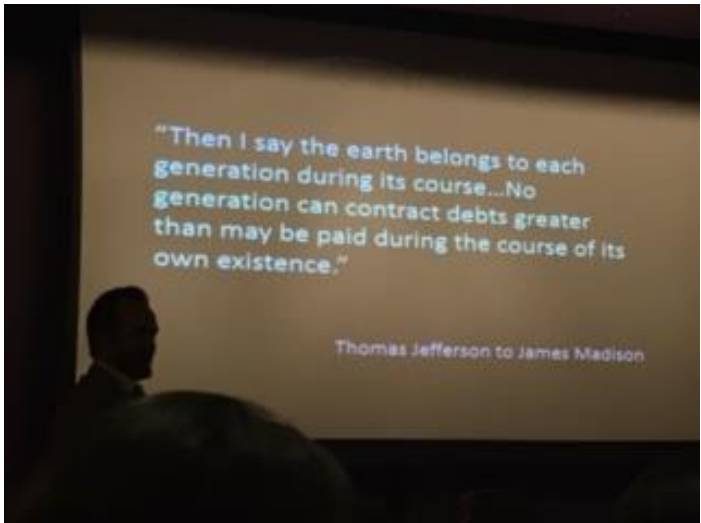
DECA SERVING THE COMMUNITY

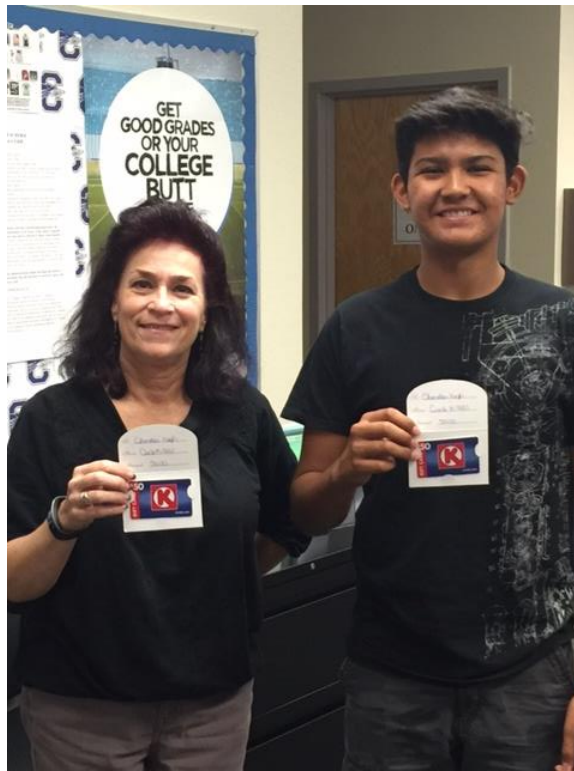
Senior Cap and Gown orders will be taken in the courtyard during lunch A and B on November 2nd and 3rd.
