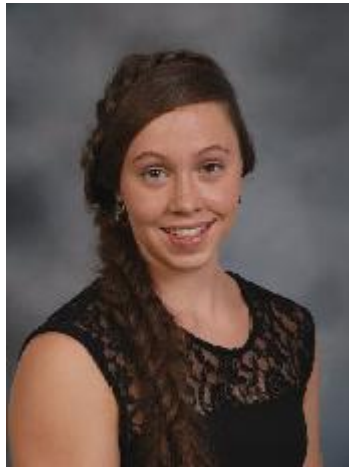

FAFSA OPEN LAB NIGHT

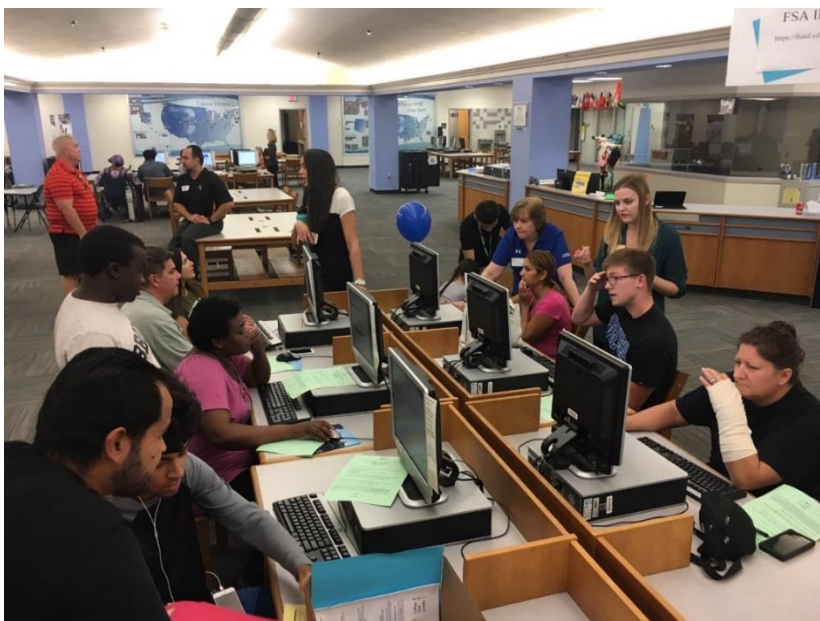

CAREER SPOTLIGHT

Have you ever thought about a job in the Health/Medical Field?

Dental Hygienists make \$70,000-\$79,000 a year with an Associate's Degree. Dental Assistants make between \$30,000-38,000 with a certificate program. Mesa Community College and Rio Solado Community College both offer these programs.

Registered Nurses start out in the \$54,000 or more range with an Associate's Degree. Licensed Practical Nurses start out in the \$40,000 or more range with a training certificate. These programs are offered at Gateway Community College, Mesa Community College and Chandler Gilbert Community College. Nurse Practitioners make a median salary of \$88,000. This position requires a Master's Degree.

Radiology Technologists start out in the \$43,000-51,000 range with an Associate's Degree from Gateway Community College. Radiologists have a median salary of \$370,000 this job requires a Doctorate of Medicine.
