- Give bookstore your envelope with student name, grade, email address, & ID number on it. In the envelope include Senior Ad Order Form which shows page option ($\frac{1}{8}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, full).
- If you are NOT submitting through email, include Senior Ad form, photos & TYPED text in envelope. You are encouraged to send photos & text thru email address below.
- Count the photo spaces on the yearbook spread that you have chosen, and only send that many
 photos through the email. You may only be able to send 1 to 3 photos maximum for each email you
 send us. This is the preferred way of sending photos & text to us. Pictures will NOT be returned! If
 you do not have email, you can submit photos on a CD put it in an envelope and then give to
 Bookstore.

Also, text must be typed and sent to the email address below. If you have no access to a computer, the information will be available at the school bookstore.
