LINK CREW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

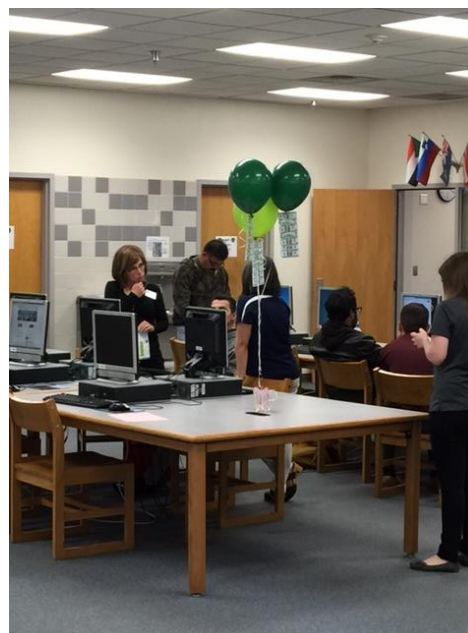
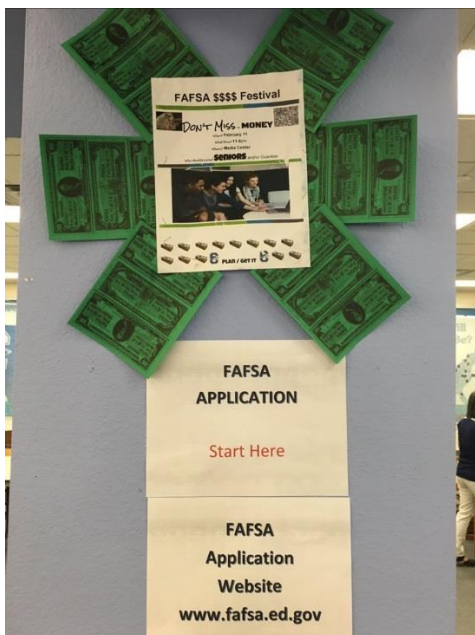
