



## WINNING WOLVES

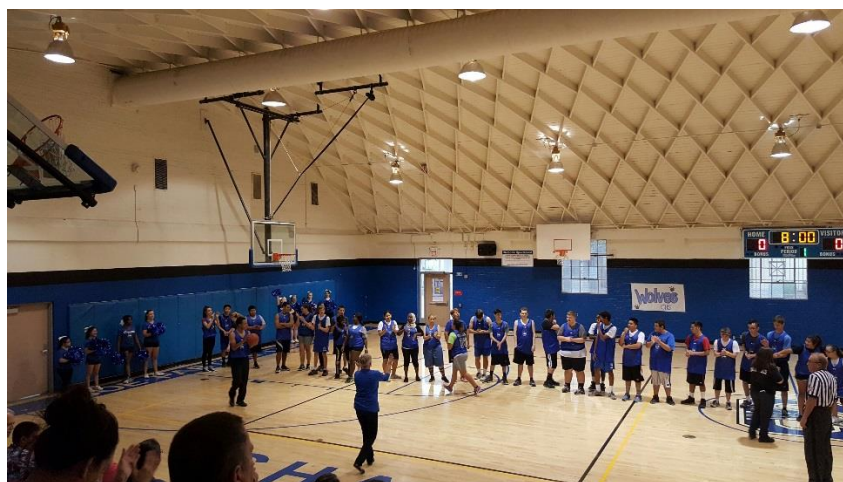

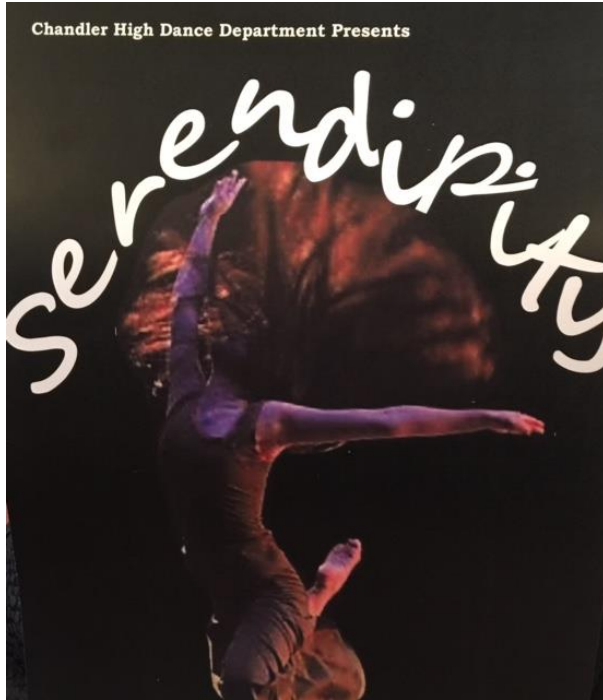
## IB ART SHOW
