Of those 20,000 students in attendance, 400 were from the state of Arizona, and 15 of those 400 earned the right to get on stage; 2 of those 15 were from Chandler High School. Competition was tough and these two individuals studied hard to earn this honor.

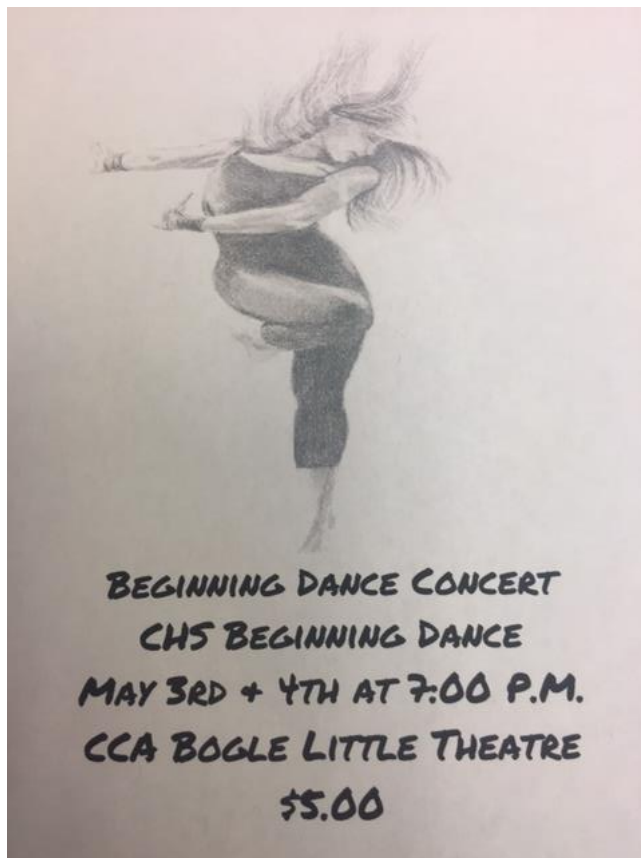


CTE BOAT RACES

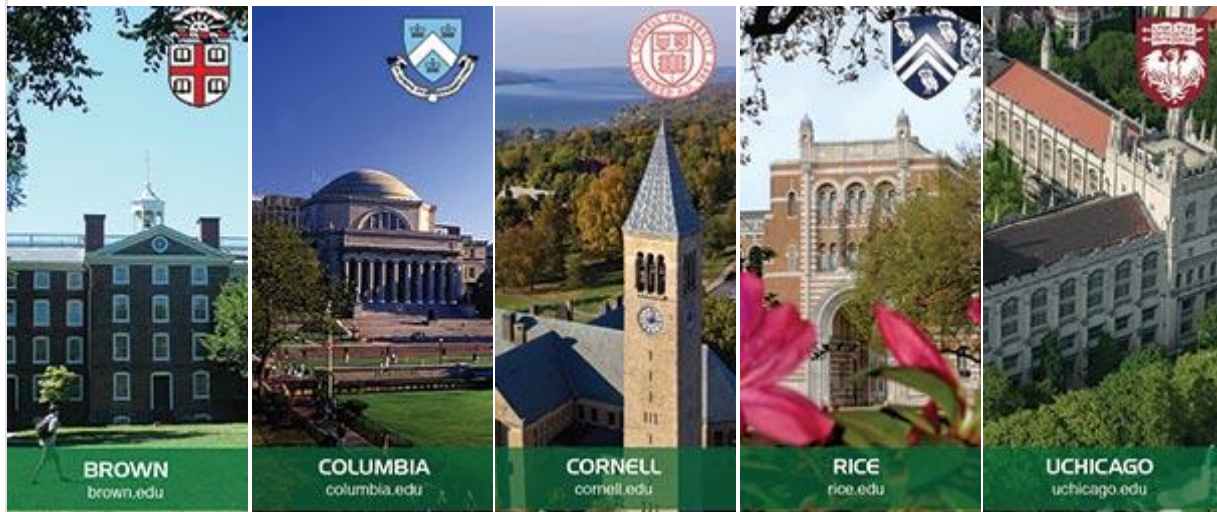


Brown University, Columbia University, Cornell University, Rice University, and the University of Chicago will be hosting a joint information session in your area.




