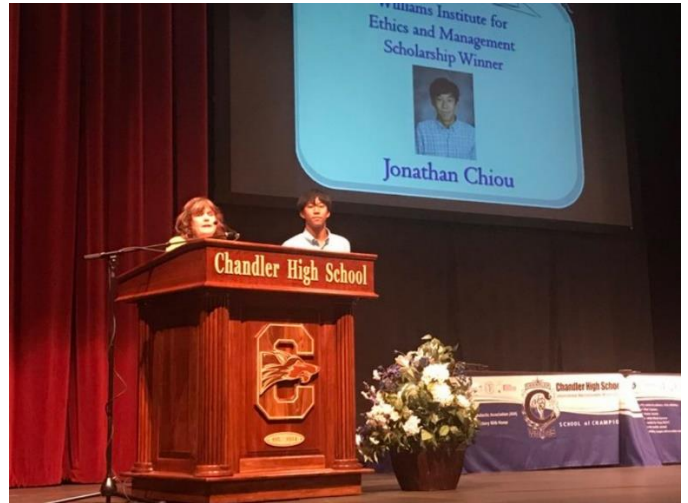
BOYS VOLLEYBALL SECOND IN STATE
