AP SCHOLARS

Congratulations to Chandler High's 2016 AP (Advanced Placement) Scholars! 120 Wolves earned Scholar distinction and averaged 3.57 on AP Exams taken last May. Excellent work!

- Sixty-two students were named AP Scholars, sitting for three or more AP Exams and scoring a 3 or higher.
- Sixteen students earned AP Scholar with Honor titles for receiving an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams.
- Forty-two students were named AP Scholars with Distinction for receiving an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.
- Six students were named National AP Scholars for receiving an average score of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams.
