CUSD BOND FACTS: DID YOU KNOW?

1. Why does the district need to sell bonds to meet its capital needs?

During the great recession, the State cut virtually all capital funds provided to build/renovate schools. In 2008 the district received \$25,000,000 in capital funding. Effective in 2009 to present, the district has received no funding to build/renovate schools.

2. Why does the District sell bonds to renovate facilities?

We have an obligation to maintain the community's investments in our buildings and grounds. Wear and tear is extraordinary; imagine 500 students using your bathroom, once a day or more, 180 days a school year for 20 years. We try to renovate restrooms every 20 years!
