




## WINNING WOLVES

Congratulations to Chandler High's 2015 AP (Advanced Placement) Scholars! 118 Wolves earned Scholar distinction and averaged 3.67 on AP Exams taken last May. Excellent work!

- *Sixty-five students* were named AP Scholars, sitting for three or more AP Exams and scoring a 3 or higher.
- *Twenty students* earned AP Scholar with Honor titles for receiving an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams.
- *Thirty-three students* were named AP Scholars with Distinction for receiving an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.
- *Nine students* were named National AP Scholars for receiving an average score of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams.



Congratulations to CHS Wrestler Jason Holmes for his outstanding performance at the National Tournament in Fargo, ND July 20<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>. Jason is now a National Champion in Freestyle and took 4<sup>th</sup> in Greco Roman.


