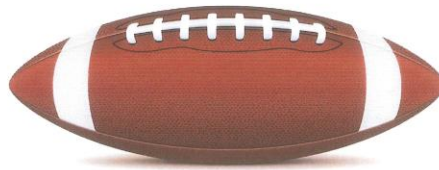

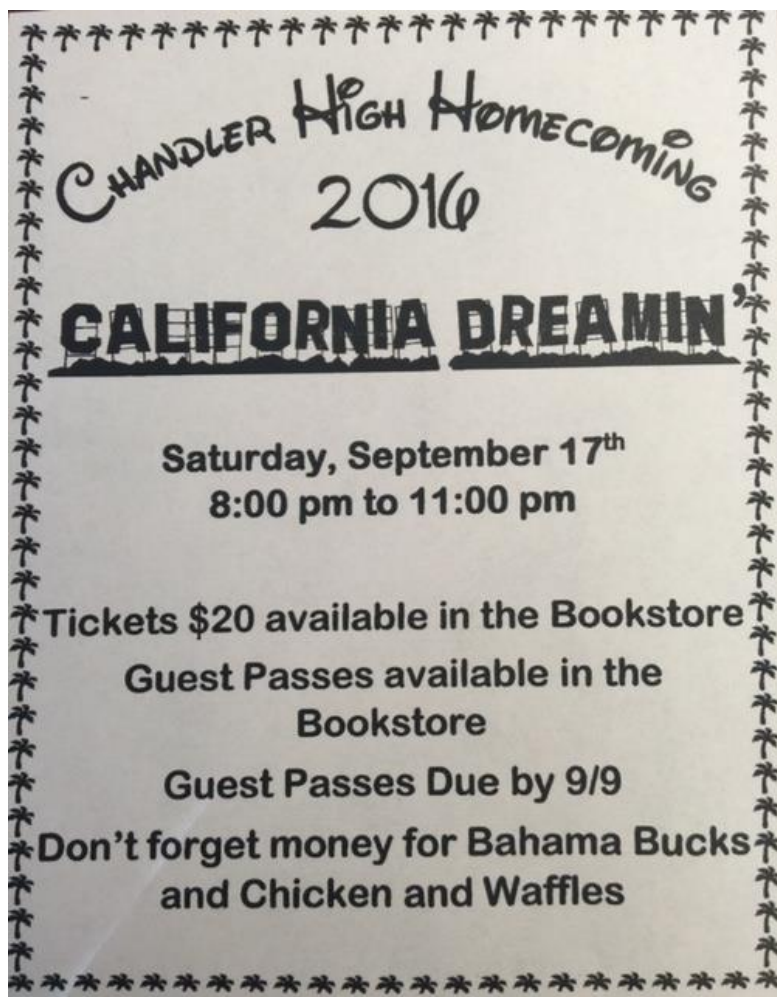

LINK CREW

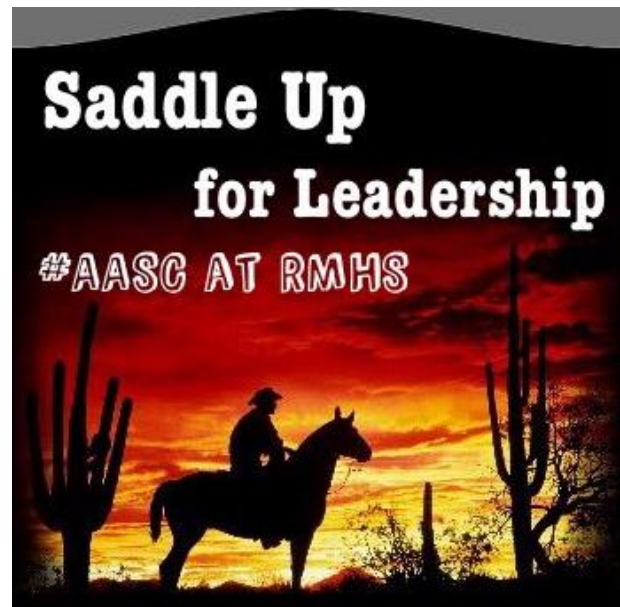
