SPIRITLINE TOY DRIVE



- 1. The Chandler Unified School District continues to grow approximately 600 to 1000 students a year which requires additional classrooms, related furniture, technology and equipment.
- 2. Funding is necessary to maintain and protect the District's \$683,000,000 investment in existing facilities. Currently the State is only providing the District with \$3,069,209 in additional district assistance to help maintain our facilities annually.
