NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

INFORMATION, REMINDERS, AND UPDATES FOR 2015-2016

- In an effort to help freshmen transition to high school level academics, students who are not prepared with completed homework assignments will be assigned to a mandatory after school "9th hour." This opportunity for freshmen to complete the assignment and receive help as needed from their teachers will be held Monday through Thursday from 2:30 to 4 P.M. Late bus transportation will be available.
- CHS continues the two lunch schedule. Lunch A students (freshmen and some scheduled upper classmen) are required to stay on campus for the entire closed campus lunch period. Lunch B is designated "modified open campus" where upper classmen (if not scheduled for Lunch A) may walk to a nearby restaurant or stay on campus. There is no driving off campus for lunch. Half-day Seniors are allowed to leave after their last class of the day.

- Please note the Final Exam policy as it appears in the student handbook: *Students may not take semester final exams prior to the time they are scheduled. Students who are absent during semester final exams will receive an F for the final exam. In order for the grade to be changed, students must take the final within the first two weeks of the next semester as arranged through administration. All Chandler High School students will take Final Exams.*
- Again this year, the Student Handbook will be available on-line. Students may request a hard copy if needed. All incoming freshmen and new students will receive a printed copy soon after the start of school. CHS administrators review the handbook in detail at meetings with freshmen during the first week of school, and teachers will review the on-line version with grades 10-12 students in their classrooms.
