- Have your child do their work as an established routine. Please do NOT give them answers. We are trying to instill independence, so read them the instructions and then let them try to do the work by themselves.

 - When we have PE make sure to dress your child in gym shoes!
- This year, we will have the same daily schedule! This schedule will change each quarter. I will update you when the quarter ends. To see our schedule, check the newsletter I attach to the homework each week ©
- Students are expected to behave and follow all directions while at their special classes.

Snack Time

- Each afternoon our Kinders are allowed to eat snack. This is something you can provide for your student each day.

 - Veggie straws, cheeze-its are fine!
- Please make sure to pack a water bottle for you student every day!

Lunch

- Students may bring a lunch from home or receive a lunch from school.

- After 20 minutes, in the cafeteria, students have a 20 minute recess outside.
