Auxier Elementary Safety Protocols & Procedures for Reopening

Auxier Elementary & Chandler Unified are committed to providing a positive learning environment by continuing to ensure the safety of our students & staff is the top priority. As we reopen our school for the 2020-2021 school year, Auxier Elementary will be implementing the following enhanced protocols &procedures to keep our school community safe & slow the spread of COVID-19. Every effort will be made to create a natural learning environment while the safety protocols are in place.

Face Coverings

- All staff, students, & visitors with an appointment MUST wear a facial covering while on campus and on school buses
- Students may be given opportunities for face covering breaks during the school day including:
 - Mealtimes--Breakfast, Lunch, & Snack
 - During Physical Activities or Recess, depending on the activity
 - In the Classroom, when social distancing is maximized

Health Screening & Protocols

- Students & Staff are required to screen themselves on a daily basis before arriving at school
- If you answer "YES" to any of the following questions, keep your student home from school & notify the Front Office of the absence.
 - 1. Does your child currently have a fever above 100.4 or had a fever in the last 24 hours?
 - 2. Does your child have any of the following symptoms?
 - New Cough or Shortness of Breath
 Headache &/or Body Ache
 Sore Throat
 Vomiting
 - Headache &/or Body Ache
 - Loss sense of taste or smell
 - Chills

- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- 3. Is anyone in your home currently being isolated for COVID-19 due to a positive test or COVID-19 symptoms?
- 4. Have you been in close contact with someone that has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or has symptoms compatible with COVID-19 in the last 24 hours?
- If any of the above symptoms appear during the school day, students will be evaluated by the Health Assistant & isolated within the Health Office.
 - Should it be determined that the student cannot be in school, the Parent/Guardian will be contacted & the student MUST be picked up within I hour of being notified
- Hand Washing &/or Hand Sanitization will occur throughout the school day:
 - Upon arrival to the classroom
 - After Physical Activity
 - Before & After Meals
 - After Sneezing, Coughing, &/or Blowing Nose



Modifications have been made to our procedures to limit the risk of exposure & for the safety of all persons at school

!!Only Students & Staff!! are permitted to be on campus beyond the designated drop-off & pick-up areas

Drivers **MUST** remain in their vehicle at all times during drop-off & pick-up

◆ Due to these procedural changes, we are anticipating higher than normal wait times during after school pick-up. ◆

Bus

- o Students who qualify for transportation have the option to ride the bus to &/or from school
- o Face Coverings & Hand Sanitization is required to board & ride on the bus
- o Students must follow the seating assignments provided by the bus driver
- Kindergarten & 1st Grade students must have an older sibling or adult at the bus stop to be released from the bus

Walkers

- o Students walking on & off campus will follow the designated route
- Kindergarten & 1st Grade students must have an older sibling or adult with them to walk off campus

Parent Pick-Up & Drop-Off

- o Students will report to the classrooms upon arrival to school
 - Staff will be available to help students, especially Kindergarten, find their way to their classroom
 - Parents/Guardians will not be permitted into the school building
- o Drivers MUST remain in their vehicle at all times during drop-off & pick-up
- o Parking lots will be closed during drop-off & pick-up times
- Drop-Off & Pick-Up Zone has been extended to provide additional unloading & loading opportunities

Campus Modifications

- Minimize the number of students in common areas &/or during physical activities
- Appointments are required to visit the Front Office &/or meet with staff on campus
- Classroom volunteers will not be permitted on campus
- Drinking fountains will be closed throughout the school
 - Students should bring a <u>labeled</u> water bottle to school every day; Water bottles can be refilled throughout the day with the classroom sinks
- Students will follow transition & hallway procedures including directional markers, social distancing,
 & staggered times
- Classroom & areas around campus will be reconfigured to maximize social distancing when possible
- Increase daily cleaning & disinfecting of high-traffic areas and horizontal surfaces
- Shared supplies (pens, pencils, crayons, school materials, etc.) will be limited
- · Large school gatherings, assemblies, &/or celebrations will be provided in an alternative format
- Signage displayed campus-wide promoting safe & healthy behaviors

Mealtime Modifications

Breakfast

- After arriving to the classroom, students participating in the Breakfast program will be dismissed by the teacher to obtain their meal in the Cafeteria/MPR
- o Supervised & Social Distanced seating will be provided, along with hand sanitizing stations

Lunch

- o Students will wash their hands prior to arrival in the cafeteria
- Cafeteria capacity will be limited to one grade level
- o Tables will be spread apart throughout the cafeteria to provide adequate social distancing
- Face coverings will not be worn while students are eating/drinking
- Seating will be limited to 2 students per table

o Meal Options for Students:

- 1. Bring a lunch from home
- 2. Purchase a lunch from the cafeteria
 - NOTE: Meals are pre-packed & served by the cafeteria staff; Self-selection choices are limited
- In order to maintain safety protocols, <u>visitors will not be allowed during lunch service</u>

Snacks & Birthday Treats

- o Students must bring a healthy snack from home
- o Grade Level, Shared Snacks, &/or Food-Related Birthday Treats are not permitted
