Please review all information carefully. This year, <u>all exams (except where noted) will be given at the First</u> <u>Baptist Chandler Church located at 3405 S. Arizona Ave</u>. Students who drive to school will still park in their designated parking space at Hamilton, before crossing the street to the church. All students **must use the crosswalk** when crossing the street at the light on Appleby and Arizona Avenue supervised by HHS Security. No building entry until staff announcement. Enter the church lobby using the doors facing Arizona Ave.

<u>Morning Exams:</u> Arrive at the church by **7:15 AM** for check in. Exam starts at 8:00 AM. <u>Afternoon Exams:</u>

Arrive at the church by **11:30 AM** for check in. Exam starts at 12:00 PM.

VERY IMPORTANT: No entry once the exam has started.

***YOU MAY NOT DRIVE TO THE CHURCH IN THE MORNING OR IN AFTERNOON.

You must use the crosswalk to cross the street. No building entry until staff announcement

- If you are taking a morning exam, you will be excused from zero hour on that day and the times you are testing.
- You must stay for the entire testing time. No one may leave early and parents may not check you out before testing is completed. If you were to leave early, you will have to forfeit the exam and may not retake it.
- If you have back-to-back tests on the same day, there will be a <u>short</u> lunch break. Bring a sack lunch and eat between testing. Afternoon exams will start on time as designated. You may not leave the church grounds in between tests.
- If you ride the bus: You will need to provide your own transportation on these days, **buses will not run early or stay late for AP testers.**
- Exams may run late. Students will not be dismissed until the exam has officially ended and dismissed by staff.
- Parents be prepared that you will not hear from your student until testing has concluded & they're dismissed.
- Emails will be sent out through Total Registration prior to test day. Make sure to read those announcements for important information or changes to the testing schedule.
- Failure to comply with any of the requirements may result in score cancellations by College Board.

What to Bring to the Exam Room:

- □ Students will need to wear a mask at all times during AP testing and in the building.
- A photo ID. <u>Students will not be allowed to test without a photo ID</u>
- □ Several sharpened #2 pencils (with erasers) for all responses on your multiple-choice answer sheet.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams. Please bring pens/pencils in a clear zip lock baggie, no pencil cases/pouches.
- □ You may bring a watch. Make sure it does not beep and there are no alarms/timers. No smart watches or Fitbits.
- □ Approved calculators, if you're taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Physics or Statistics exam. Visit <u>apstudents.org/calculators</u> to learn more about the calculator policy.
- □ A ruler or straight-edge, only if you're taking an AP Physics Exam.
- Students may want to bring a sweatshirt, to be comfortable in the air-conditioned room, **no blankets**.

What NOT to Bring to the Exam Room:

- No phones, smartwatches, wearable technology of any kind, computers, Bluetooth devices, portable listening or recording devices, headphones, Fitbits, cameras or photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, and any other electronic devices are **prohibited in the exam room and during breaks.**
- □ No books, compasses, correction fluid, mechanical pencils, dictionaries, highlighters, notes or colored pencils.
- □ No scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets).
- □ No watches that have internet access, beep or have an alarm.
- □ No pencil pouches/cases (only clear see through ones or baggies)
- □ No blankets, pillows, stuffed animals, earplugs, clipboards or clothing with subject-related information.
- □ No food or drink in the testing room, including water.
