Release of Curriculum Maps

The CUSD ELA and Math Curriculum Maps identify the sequence of instruction to be taught at each grade level quarterly intervals. The information is intended to serve as a resource to help guide instruction. While Arizona Standards are the basis for curriculum, each grade-specific map aligns state standards to district-adopted resources. Included anchor standards emphasize the knowledge, understanding, and skills students must acquire by the end of each grade. Additionally, a yearly overview of the cyclical standards which build in complexity is included for each grade.

The CUSD Curriculum Maps are designed to accommodate the dynamic process of ongoing curriculum and assessment review. As a result, maps are best utilized digitally so expected updates and revisions can be immediate. In regard to pacing, the K-6 Curriculum Maps identify the sequence of instruction at each grade level to be taught at quarterly intervals, while the 7-12 Curriculum Maps identify this sequence at semester intervals.
