Our Goal

Our goal is to ensure every student has equal access to healthy and nutritious meals needed to thrive in a learning environment. The CUSD Food & Nutrition Angel Fund seeks to provide short-term assistance to families in need by covering negative lunch account balances and ensuring no child goes hungry throughout the school year.

What We Do

We serve over 26,000 meals per day, around 250 of these meals are served to students who do not have enough money in their account to pay. We intentionally serve these students the same meals as their peers as to not stigmatize the student and allow them to enjoy the same meal choices as their peers. As an equal opportunity provider, we are committed to working with families and should the need arise for assistance, helping them with access to free and reduced priced meals if eligible.

What we need

Our policy equates to a cost of over \$40,000 each year that is covered by the District Food & Nutrition Department. **We need your help** in ensuring we can continue to serve every child. You can choose to donate to an individual school's meal fund or the district's general meal fund.
