

Dear Parent/Guardians,

At Weinberg we are always striving to create a safe and stimulating learning environment for all students. In an effort to continue to improve our school climate, our staff has worked together to form a school wide behavior plan. The focus of this plan is to establish school wide expectations and to create a positive school climate that fosters students to be respectful, responsible, and ready to learn.

To help students to be informed and reminded of our expectations, we will display posters around the building and in the classrooms. Our staff will teach and reinforce the positive behaviors that students are expected to demonstrate at school. We will acknowledge and reward students who consistently demonstrate these positive behaviors.

We are excited to implement a quarterly celebration for students who demonstrate these positive behaviors throughout the quarter.

There will be 1 BIG celebration at the end of the school year in addition to the 4th quarter celebration for students who have had good behavior ALL year (meaning they attended all 4 quarter reward celebrations).

Students will get to participate in the quarterly celebration if they meet the following requirements:

Grades K-3

- Minimum of one lunch detention during the quarter.
- No suspensions
- Student does not receive more than the following behavior alerts for each quarter.
 - Q1: 4 Q2:3 Q3: 2 Q4: 1

Grades 4-6

- Zero Lunch Detentions
- No Suspensions
- Student does not receive more than the following behavior alerts for each quarter.
 - Q1: 4 Q2:3 Q3: 2 Q4: 1

With your continued support and involvement, there is no question that our school will continue to be a place where students can excel in a safe and stimulating environment. Research shows that when the home and school work together, student learning is more successful. We look forward to working with you as true partners in your child's education!
