EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY TAX CREDIT ONLINE

Please reach out to friends and family to donate. The great news with tax credit donations is the money is returned, dollar for dollar, when filing state income tax.



Tax credit is a full refund, not a deduction.

Please help by staying in your cars as you pull forward along the curb where students load and unload.

Kinder and first grade parents - we ask that you do not stop at the curve by the kinder playground. This causes more cars to be lined up in the street. Please pull forward all the way, and our safety patrol and staff will make sure the children reach the playground.

ATTENDANCE/ABSENCES – We regard educating your child as one of the most important jobs in the world and we need your support. There is no substitute for time spent in the classroom. When illness or an emergency makes it necessary for your child to be absent, please call the attendance line at 812-7503 (Attendance Line Available 24 Hours). Remember to report the absence with the following information:

- Child's name and grade
- Caller's name and relationship to the student (mother, father, etc.)
- Reason for absence

<u>TARDY STUDENTS</u> - Make sure to have your child come directly to the office to sign-in and receive a tardy pass before going to his/her assigned classroom. <u>If children arrive after 8:35 a.m., they are considered late and</u> <u>must report to the office with a parent/guardian who will sign the student in before going to the classroom.</u> Students who have 1 tardy will not qualify for perfect attendance for that grading period. Please make every effort to have your child ride the bus or be dropped off by 8:30 a.m.

<u>PICKING UP STUDENTS</u> - If you need to pick up your student early, the office will call the student down when you have signed them out in the office. We will no longer call students down to the office prior to a parent signing them out in the office or after 2:30 pm. If someone else is picking up your student during school hours, please call the office or email the teacher/office to let us know who will be signing out your student. The person signing the student will need to show valid id to pick up the students and must be 18 or over. Individuals listed on your emergency card are for emergency (injury/sick incidents) and are not considered a blanket approval by parents for all occasions.
