READING

What you can do at home:

- Make a space for reading
- Have your child read to you every night!
- Pick "good fit" books!
- Lexia
- Ask your child questions about homework, stories, movies, shows, ANYTHING!
 - i.e. main idea, predications, characters, etc.
- Encourage your child to use their weekly vocabulary in their every day

Foundations

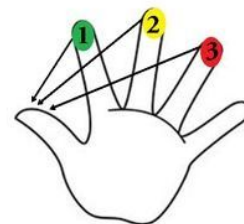
- Multi-sensory systematic program that supports students' phonics, spelling, and handwriting skills
- Weekly phonics skill/concept
 - i.e. digraphs, blends, r-controlled vowels, etc.
- Unit assessment of unit skills

LITERACY

What you can do at home:

- Ask questions
 - Students should be able to “teach” you
- Practice tapping out sounds in words (each sound is a tap)
- Cursive handwriting practice

- Cooking/baking for measurement

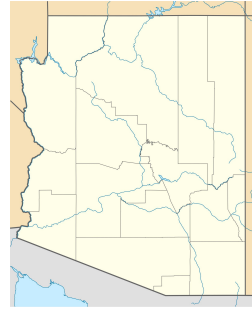

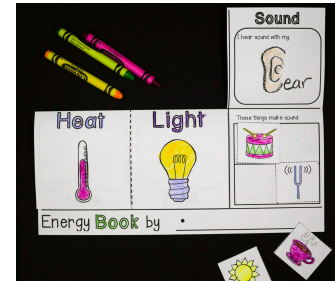

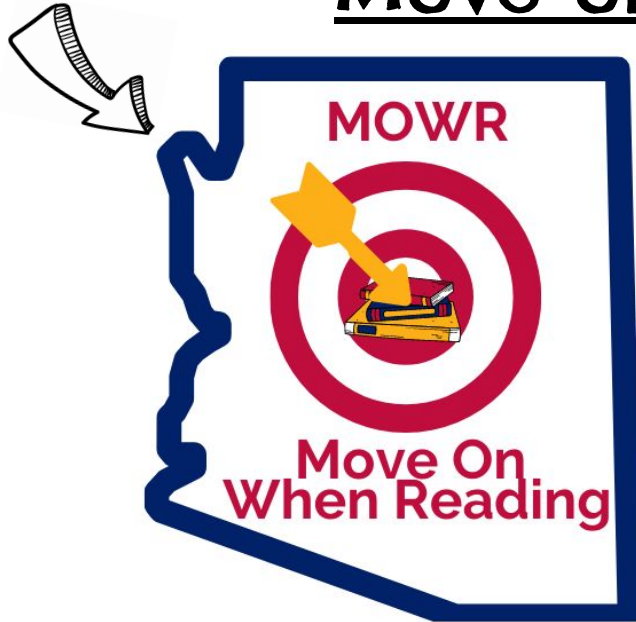

Arizona's Move On When Reading policy is designed to provide students with evidence-based, effective reading instruction in kindergarten through third grade in order to position them for success as they progress through school, college, and career.

The legislation in [A.R.S §15-701](#), [A.R.S §15-704](#), and [A.R.S §15-211](#) (as amended by [HB2026](#)) explains the requirements for pupil promotion, early literacy instruction, and accountability for student achievement in reading.

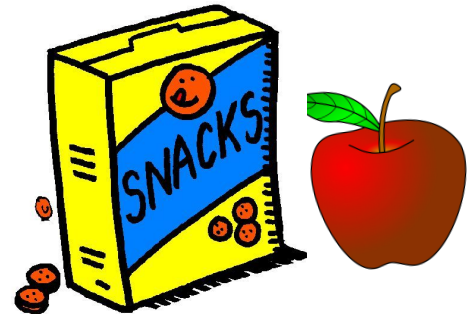

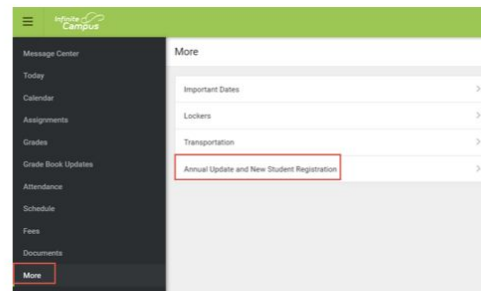


How to access the Annual Update/Emergency and Health Update Application

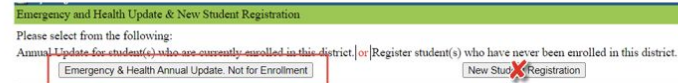
Step 1: Login to your [Parent Portal](#)

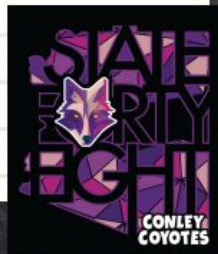

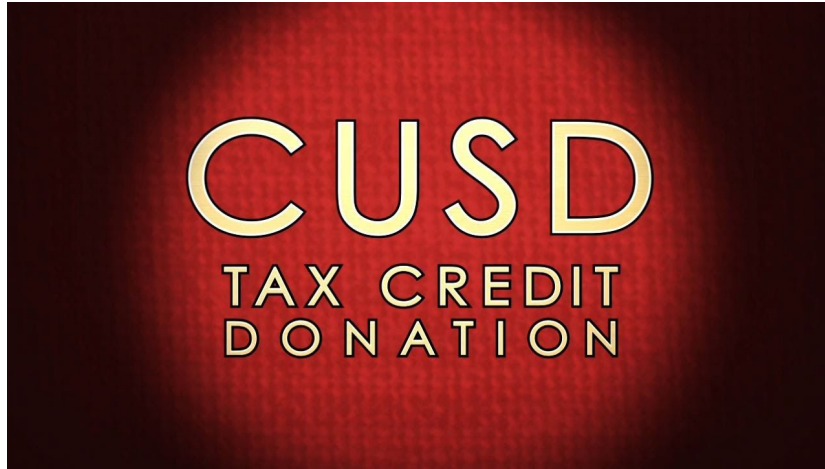
