

- Students earn incentives from Class Dojo Store on Fridays every increment of 10 points








- Encourage your child to use their weekly vocabulary in their every day


Fundations

- Multi-sensory systematic program that supports students' phonics, spelling, and handwriting skills
- Weekly phonics skill/concept
 - i.e. digraphs, blends,
 r-controlled vowels, etc.
- Unit assessment of unit skills



What you can do at home:

- Ask questions
 - Students should be able to "teach" you
- Practice tapping out sounds in words (each sound is a tap)
- Cursive handwriting practice

- Conventions, fluency, organization, voice, word choice, presentation
- Narratives, informative/explanatory, and opinion essays

*Enter Arrowhead off Frye Rd.


*Turn RIGHT onto Coyote Way
