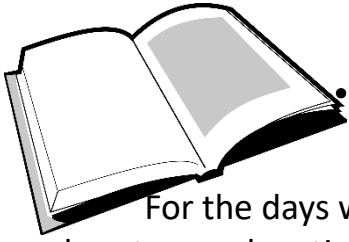

Class Schedule

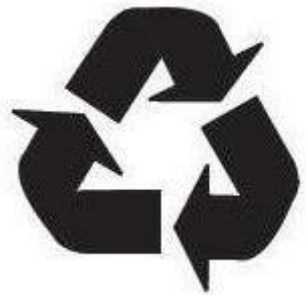
For the days we are online, your class will have a specific schedule. When you tune in each day at your class time, you can expect the following:

- **5 to 10 minute video** – This will be your lesson for the class. Make sure to watch it!
- **Discussion question** – This will be a question based on the lesson. I will post it about 5 minutes into class. Answers will be used to take attendance for the class, so please don't skip this!
- **Activity** – This will be posted about 5 minutes into class. After you do the discussion question, you'll attempt the day's activity. If you have questions, I'll be online and ready to answer emails or comments on the assignment.
- **Google Meet** – In the last 15 minutes of class, I will make a Google Meet and post the link. If you are still struggling with the activity, you can join the google meet and ask me any questions you have over video. **The Google Meet is 100% optional.**

What will be Different?

Normally we start the Tournament Robotics year with teambuilding activities. Since we are online, we will start with class procedures and expectations, then take a look at what the next vex tournament is.

If online learning continues longer than expected, then we will use programs like VEXCode VR to learn about programming the robot, as well as start brainstorming robot ideas for when we return in person.
