### Do You Need A Break? We Can Help With Respite



A re you thinking of sending your grandchild to a spring break camp, enrolling them in an extracurricular activity, or sending them to a summer program? Duet understands that finances may not always allow you to enroll in these types of activities that benefit both grandparents and grandchildren. We may be able to help your grandchildren attend these wonderful programs while offering you some time for yourself through our respite care service which may pay for part or all of the registration fees. Contact Patricia Dominguez at (602) 274-5022 for an appointment to see if you qualify for assistance.

## If you are interested in respite assistance, be prepared to:

 Show legal custody for your grandchildren, such as guardianship, non-parent custody, etc. Answer questions about your unique situation (about a 30-minute process).

- Give the name of the agency that will be providing the respite services; include the provider's full address, phone number and the name of a contact person.
- Give the start-and-end dates of the program, and class frequency. (*i.e. every Mon. and Wed.*)
- If approved, it takes 10 business days to process the request. No exceptions.

**Gaining Guardianship of Your Grandchild** 

randparents and other relatives who care for children often face legal issues, whether they are dealing with custody or guardianship, or getting medical care for a child. Do you know whether you need to be the legal guardian of your grandchildren? Duet can help answer that question and let you know of options available to you. If you are raising a grandchild or a minor relative in Arizona, you will need formal custody to obtain benefits such as healthcare, or to enroll the child in school. While the legal process to gain custody can be complex and overwhelming, Duet is here to help



connect you to the appropriate legal support.

We have partnered with the Children's Law Center through Community Legal Services to provide a FREE clinic to help you complete the proper paperwork.
