

Monday - Thursday Attire Guide

Collar Required; ACP, College, and Military Themes

Shirts	Approved ACP Polo's (purple, black, grey, or white with ACP logo) approved white oxford shirts with ACP logo required
Pants/Shorts/Capris/Skirts/Skorts	Approved black, khaki, grey, navy blue or plaid in school colors. Denim is allowed, as are solid black, grey, or navy yoga pants leggings, Sweatpants and pajama bottoms are not permitted.
Sweaters, jackets, hoodies, and sweatshirts	Outerwear must be in any combination of school colors. Outerwear promoting any military branch or college and university is also permitted and may be any color and any type.
Socks	Socks must be worn with closed-toed shoes. Tights may be worn and cotton socks above the knee may be worn if they are in school colors.
Shoes	Shoes must be worn at all times. Flip flops (ones that could be worn around water) and slippers are not permitted on campus. Heels or platforms of shoes must not exceed 2 inches due to safety reasons.
Undershirts/Turtlenecks	Short and long-sleeve undershirts/turtlenecks in solid black, purple or white are permitted.
Headwear and Sunglasses	Hats and sunglasses are not permitted in the building (unless approved by administration)

Friday Attire Guidelines

Shirts	ACP t-shirts or polos are permitted as are shirts that promote any school-related activity (e.g. AIA State Championship, VEX Robotics, Knight Games, etc.), shirts that promote a college/university or branch of the military are also permitted to be worn on Friday's.
Pants/Shorts/Capris/Skirts/Skort	Black, khaki, grey, navy blue or plaid in school colors. Denim is allowed, as are solid black, grey, or navy yoga pants and leggings. Sweatpants and pajama bottoms are not permitted.
Sweaters, jackets, hoodies, and sweatshirts	Outerwear must be in any combination of school colors. Outerwear promoting any military branch or college and university is also permitted and may be any color and any type.
Socks	Socks must be worn with closed-toed shoes. Tights may be worn and cotton socks above the knee may be worn if they are in school colors.
Shoes	Shoes must be worn at all times. Flip flops (ones that could be worn around water) and slippers are not permitted on campus. Heels or platforms of shoes must not exceed 2 inches due to safety reasons.
Undershirts/Turtlenecks	Short and long-sleeve undershirts/turtlenecks in solid black, purple or white are permitted.
Headwear and Sunglasses	Hats and sunglasses are not permitted in the building (unless approved by administration)
