#### **Online Expectations:**

- Check into Google Classroom daily! There will be new assignments and videos every scheduled class day. Logging in and checking google classroom daily will keep you from missing an assignment.

\*\*\* There will not be a video lesson every single day. On some days you may have a quiz or test.


## **GRADING POLICY**

- Calculated on a point system that is a 80% 20% split with Tests and Quizzes worth 80%.
- Semester grades are based on a 40-40-20. Each quarter is worth 40% and the Final Exam is 20%.
- No extra credit is offered and per Math department policy, no test retakes are given.
- A standard scale is used:
  - **A**: 90-100% **B**: 80-89%
    - **C**: 70-79%
    - **D**: 60-69%

**F**: 59% and below (no credit is given and the student must retake the class)

• There will be no retakes for any tests on an individual student basis. A teacher may elect to reteach topics and then retest these topics for the entire class if they feel it will benefit the students and deepen their understanding of the concepts.

• For all courses at the Algebra II level and above there will be no test corrections made after a test has been graded and recorded that will count for points back on that specific test. The assignment may be given for homework points only.

• For courses that are giving common assessments, the test must be given within the same week as all other course of that level. The assessment scores may be shared with students and then collected for test/quiz security.
