**Parent Information: This is our weekly lesson plan. It tells families what the students are working on each week, the skills addressed in each activity, and upcoming

important events. In our program, the students will be introduced to monthly thematic units (i.e. "Ready For School", "My Family", etc) and science themes (i.e. "Science Tools", "Nutrition/Fitness", etc). There are also weekly math concepts (i.e. "Patterns, "Measurement", "Counting 1-5", etc.) introduced. The first semester, in our literacy curriculum "Fundations", the students learn letter names and sounds. In <u>1st semester</u>, we work on "letter names/sounds". This week, we work introduce the ABCs.

**COLOR OF THE MONTH! At the end of each month, students have an opportunity to wear the COLOR OF THE MONTH at our "Color of the Month" party. Students can bring a toy or snack to share that is the COLOR OF THE MONTH. August's COLOR OF THE MONTH is RED!

**Show and Tell YES, EACH THURSDAY is "Show and Tell"! Students are allowed to bring one toy/item from home in their backpack to show their friends and tell about it during Circle time. This is a great activity for social skills and language! The toy/item is kept in their backpack for the rest of the day and sent home.
