** Parent Information: This is our weekly lesson plan. It tells families what the students are working on each week, the skills addressed in each activity, and upcoming important

events. In our program, the students will be introduced to monthly thematic units (i.e. "My Family", "Our Community", etc.) and science themes (i.e. "Blocks Measure Up", "Magnificent Magnets", etc.). There are also weekly math concepts (i.e. "Patterns, "Measurement", "Counting 1-5", etc.) introduced. The first semester, in our literacy curriculum "Fundations", the students learn letter names and sounds. This week, we work on letter "D", "D Dog /d/".
