events. In our program, the students will be introduced to monthly thematic units (i.e. "My Family", "Our Community", etc.) and science themes (i.e. "Blocks Measure Up", "Magnificent Magnets", etc.). There are also weekly math concepts (i.e. "Patterns, "Measurement", "Counting 1-5", etc.) introduced. The first semester, in our literacy curriculum "Fundations", the students learn letter names and sounds. This week, we work on letter "E", "E Ed /e/".
