<p>PARENT INFORMATION- This is our weekly lesson plan. It tells families what the students are working on each week, the skills addressed in each activity, and upcoming important events. In our program, the students will be introduced to monthly thematic (i.e. "My Family", "Our Community", etc) and science themes ("Rainy Weather", "Blocks Measure Up", etc). There are also weekly math concepts (i.e. "Exploring Patterns", "Comparing", etc.) introduced, as well as letter formation/writing each week. The first semester, in our literacy curriculum "Fundations", the students learn letter names and sounds. This week, we focus on "G /g/ and H /h/". The students are expected to wear uniforms each day (1 provided by the school), however, at the end of each month, students have an opportunity to wear the COLOR OF THE MONTH at our "Color of the Month" party. Students can bring a toy or snack to share that is the COLOR OF THE MONTH. August's COLOR OF THE MONTH is BLUE. COLOR PARTY FOR August is Thursday, August 29 . Students are allowed to bring one toy/item from home in their backpack to show their friends and tell about it during Circle time. This is a great activity for social skills and language! The toy/item is kept in their backpack for the rest of the day and sent home.</p> <p>"REMIND" This is an APP on your smart phone to keep connected with how your child is doing in class, what he/she is doing, and upcoming events! I will send home information on how to access this.</p> <p>"READY ROSIE" This is a resource for parents to link activities at home to our curriculum at school. Themes/topics we teach at school can be reinforced at home - This is a resource to help parents do that! All families should receive an email invitation to join :).</p>
