<p><b>**PARENT INFORMATION:</b> This is our weekly lesson plan. It tells families what the students are working on each week, the skills addressed in each activity, and upcoming important events. In our program, the students will be introduced to <b>monthly thematic</b> (i.e. "GROWING UP HEALTHY", "NAURE ALL AROUND US", etc) and <b>science</b> themes ( "BEGINNING BOTANTIST", "Busy Buzzing Bees", etc). There are also <b>weekly math</b> concepts (i.e. 2D Objects, comparing/ordering quantities, day vs. night, etc.) introduced, as well as letter formation/writing each week. The first semester, in our literacy curriculum "<b>Fundations</b>", the students learned <b>letter names and sounds</b>. This second semester we <b>WORK ON LETTER FORMATION</b>..This week - "v,w". The students are expected to wear <b>uniforms</b> each day (1 provided by the school). <b>However</b>, at the end of each month, students have an <u>opportunity to wear</u> the <b>COLOR OF THE MONTH</b> at our "Color of the Month" party. Also, students can bring a toy or snack to share that is the <b>COLOR OF THE MONTH</b>. <u>MARCH'S</u> <b>COLOR OF THE MONTH</b> is "<b>GREEN</b>". <b>COLOR PARTY</b> for <b>GREEN</b> is <u>MARCH 26</u>.</p> <p><b>**"SHOW AND TELL!"</b> <b>Yes</b>, <u>each Thursday</u> is "Show and Tell". Students are allowed to bring <u>one toy/item from home</u> in their backpack to show their friends and tell about it during Circle time. This is a great activity for social skills and language! The toy/item is kept in their backpack for the rest of the day and sent home.</p> <p><b>**"REMIND"</b> This is an APP on your smart phone to keep connected with how your child is doing in class, what he/she is doing, and upcoming events! <b>PLEASE ASK ME FOR INFORMATION</b></p> <p><b>**"READY ROSIE"</b> This is a resource for parents to link activities at home to our curriculum at school. Themes/topics we teach at school can be reinforced at home.
