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PARENT INFORMATION: This is our weekly lesson plan. It tells families what the students are working on each week, the skills addressed in each activity, and upcoming important events. In our program, the students will be introduced to **monthly thematic** (i.e. "AWESOME ANIMALS, IMAGINE IT, MAKE IT", etc) and **science** themes ("FEATHERED FRIENDS, ASTONISHING AIR", etc). There are also weekly **math** concepts (i.e. NUMERALS/QUANTITIES 1-10, POSITIONS I.E. in front, on, behind, inside, etc.) introduced, as well as letter formation/writing each week. The first semester, in our literacy curriculum **"Fundations"**, the students learn **letter names and sounds**. This week we learn **"Y"**! The students are expected to wear **uniforms** each day (1 provided by the school), however, at the end of each month, students have an <u>opportunity to wear</u> the **COLOR OF THE MONTH** at our "Color of the Month" party. Also, students can bring a toy or snack to share that is the COLOR OF THE MONTH. <u>November's</u> **COLOR OF THE MONTH is BROWN. BROWN COLOR PARTY FOR November** is <u>Thursday, November 21</u>. (The ORANGE color party was a HUGE success!)

"SHOW AND TELL!" Yes, each Thursday is "Show and Tell". Students are allowed to bring one toy/item from home in their backpack to show their friends and tell about it during Circle time. This is a great activity for social skills and language! The toy/item is kept in their backpack for the rest of the day and sent home.

"REMIND" This is an APP on your smart phone to keep connected with how your child is doing in class, what he/she is doing, and upcoming events! PLEASE ASK ME FOR INFORMATION :)

"READY ROSIE" This is a resource for parents to link activities at home to our curriculum at school. Themes/topics we teach at school can be reinforced at home. This is a resource to help parents do that!

"THANKSGIVING ACTIVITY" This month we will be talking about BEING THANKFUL and doing several TURKEY CRAFTS. You child brought home a TURKEY FEATHER to decorate. Talk to your child about what they are THANKFUL FOR and write it on the back. It can be decorated with anything (i.e. dry cereal, noodles, sand, coloring, painting, stickers, material scraps, finger prints...etc.) We have a classroom FEATHERLESS turkey who has many beautiful feathers now! The kids love having their **Turkey Feathers** displayed for friends to see!
