<p><b>PARENT INFORMATION-</b> This is our weekly lesson plan. It tells families what the students are working on each week, the skills addressed in each activity, and upcoming important events. In our program, the students will be introduced to <b>monthly thematic</b> (i.e. "My Family", "Our Community", etc) and <b>science</b> themes ("Rainy Weather", "Blocks Measure Up", etc). There are also weekly <b>math</b> concepts (i.e. "Exploring Patterns", "Comparing", etc.) introduced, as well as letter formation/writing each week. The first semester, in our literacy curriculum "<b>Fundations</b>", the students learn <b>letter names and sounds</b>. This week, we focus on "I /i/, J /j/". The students are expected to wear <b>uniforms</b> each day (1 provided by the school), however, at the end of each month, students have an opportunity to wear the <b>COLOR OF THE MONTH</b> at our "Color of the Month" party. Students can bring a toy or snack to share that is the COLOR OF THE MONTH. September's <b>COLOR OF THE MONTH is YELLOW</b>. <b>COLOR PARTY FOR Sept</b> is WEDNESDAY, SEPT 25 .
