- Complete assessments in each IB Group (6 groups)
- 2 or 3 STANDARD LEVEL and 3 or 4 HIGHER LEVEL
- Can take 1 or 2 SL assessments in 11th grade
- Complete Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course (2 sem.) and a paper
- Complete an Extended Essay with feedback from an advisor

Per test fee → \$120* (IB Diploma=8 tests; IB Career=2 tests) ManageBac fee (per year) - \$15

To earn the IB Career-Related Diploma students

- Complete assessments in 2 IB curriculum subgroups
- Can be standard level or higher level
- One IB course must be taken over 2 years
- Study courses in the same CTE area for both 11 and 12 grade
 - Engineering, Computer Science, Agriculture, Marketing, Sports Medicine, TV/Media Production
- Complete Personal and Professional Skills (PPS) course (2 semesters)
- Complete a Language Portfolio through PPS
- Complete a Reflective Project that is tied with the career area with feedback from a CTE mentor teacher
- Fulfill requirements of Service Learning (50 hours total)
