Diploma students are currently working on their Internal Assessments for each of their classes.

Students should be working on their CAS hours. We met with all of the diploma students and discussed the options for their hours. We supplied various examples and ideas for their CAS project. The project is to be a month long effort and can be centered around creativity, activity or service. All CAS hours need to be completed by the end of April, 2021.
