## CUSD Preschool FAQ for Families 2020-2021

- 1. When will instruction begin? All preschool programs (Title I, Priority, and Community Education) will begin with a virtual to in-person transition model on August 5, 2020 with the intent to begin in-person instruction on August 17, 2020.
- Will preschool students participate in virtual instruction? Prior to in-person instruction, live
  meetings and self-paced educational Lessons will be provided using adopted curriculum.
  Lessons will be pre-recorded so students can participate at their convenience with parent or
  with caregiver support.
- 3. What will preschool students learn during live meetings and check-ins? Social Emotional Learning content and Get to Know You activities will be delivered via Google Meets, with parents logging-in via an email invitation from their child's teacher. See above.
- 4. Will Priority Preschool students receive additional services before in-person instruction begins? Priority Preschool teachers may provide teletherapy via Google Meets prior to in-person instruction as related to specific IEP goals.
- 5. Will I be charged for the entire month of August? Community Education preschool programs will not be charged during virtual learning. Billing will not take place until in-person instruction begins on August 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. Will my preschool student be required to wear a mask? Students younger than kindergarten age will not be required to wear a mask. Parents may opt to have their child wear a mask.
- 7. Will my child's preschool teacher wear a mask? In compliance with Maricopa County, City and Town Guidelines, all students (kindergarten and above) and patrons are required to wear face coverings on school grounds where persons are unable to maintain continuous physical distancing of 6 feet or more. See CUSD Governing Board policy.
