About the Class

In Strategies we will have lessons that will provide students strategies and assistance focusing on their interpersonal, social skills, and executive function skills. Students will have the opportunity to complete and receive assistance on class assignments, tests, as necessary according to the IEPs.

Re-teach and Homework help

In this class, you will be able to get extra help and work on assignments. It is important for students to use this time wisely. I ask that the students bring homework, projects, assignments, and any make up work. This time will be used to work on your individual classes.

**Students will be monitored to make sure they are working on assignments and using their time wisely. This will help make students accountable for their work and help me to document what they were working on.

Daily Routine/What to Expect

- Warm up activities
- Weekly grade checks / weekly reflections / student agenda
- Complete homework from other classes

Grading Policy

This is an elective class. You will earn a grade based on your participation and completion of assignments.

All grades are based on the number of points possible for any given assignment. A student's total grade for any marking period is based on the total number of points a student received divided by the total number of points possible, which will result in a percentage grade. Students will be given a mid-term exam each semester and a semester final.

The grading scale is as follows:

A = 100 - 90%

B = 89 - 80%

C = 79 - 70%

D = 69 - 60%

F = 59% and below

If a student chooses not to complete any school work during Strategies, you will be removed from the class.

It is your responsibility to be successful in school and in life. This class is designed to provide you with the tools to help. I ask that you give yourself a chance to be successful, to have a positive attitude and come to class ready to work and learn.
