Message from the Health Office - Parents of 5th grade students

There are two new immunization rules from the Arizona Department of Health Services that will affect your child. ADHS have removed the grade level from the requirements and now require these vaccines by age 11.

- Students 11 years of age and older will be REQUIRED to have one dose of Tdap vaccine IF 5 years has passed since their last Tetanus/diphtheria containing vaccine.
- Students 11 years of age and older will be REQUIRED to have one dose of Meningococcal (Meningitis) vaccine.

IF your child is 11 years old now, these immunizations are due.

Please follow up with your health care provider for these immunizations. A REMINDER letter will be sent monthly until immunizations are complete.
