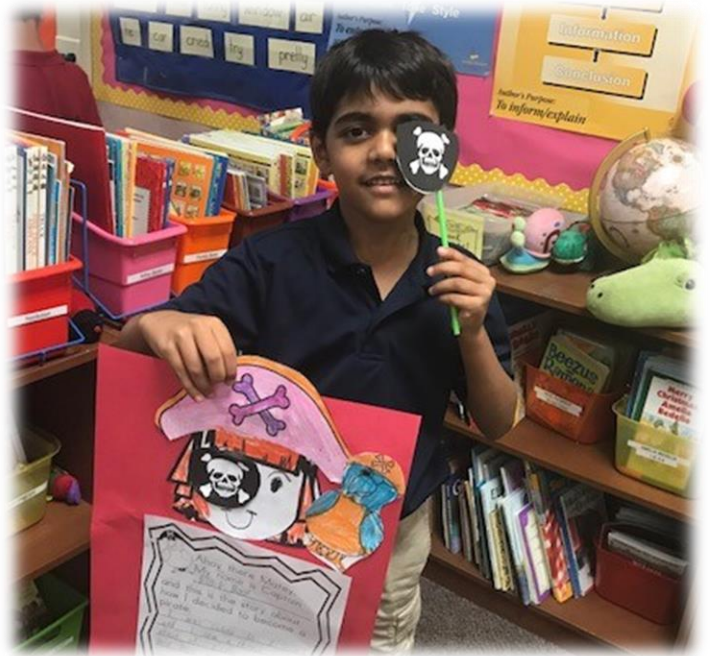

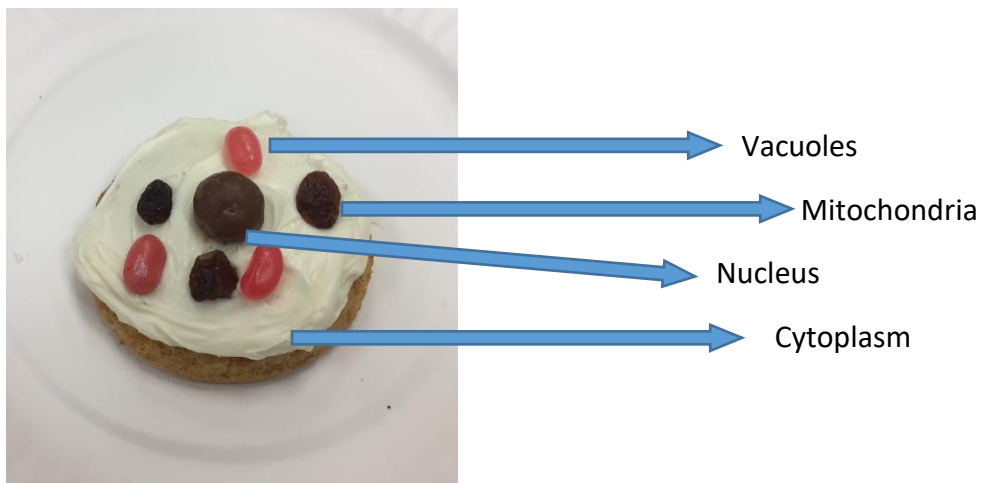


Talk Like a Pirate Day!- September 19
