

BOY'S DRESS CODE

This is the CTA mandatory dress code as it is written in the handbook.

Monday - Thursday:

- **Bottoms:**

- **Pants:** Plain dark navy blue or khaki
- **Jeans:** Plain dark navy blue denim (no fading, logos, or designs)
- **Shorts:** Must be of modest length- approximately to the knee
 - No tight fitting or big/baggy bottoms will be allowed.

- **Tops:**

- SOLID navy blue, red or white shirts
 - All shirts must be solid in color with no pin stripes or logos of any kind with the exception of the CTA campus-specific logo shirt.
 - A collar and sleeves are required.
 - When long-sleeved shirts are worn under the collared shirt, the shirts must be red, white, or navy blue.
 - All shirts **must be tucked in.**

- **Miscellaneous:**

- **Jewelry:**

- No earrings or pierced body jewelry shall be worn at school.

- **Hair:**

- Hair shall be neatly groomed and trimmed.
- **Hair length shall not be longer than the ear lobes on the side or fall below the collar in the back.**
- Bangs shall be worn above the eyebrows.
- No hair tails are permitted.
- Appropriate hairstyles, cuts, or colors are acceptable.
- No headbands, hats, or caps shall be worn at school except hats approved by the teacher or principal for sun protection on the playground.

- **OUTERWEAR:**

- **Sweaters and sweatshirts:** worn in the classroom must be predominantly navy, red, or white. Outerwear worn outside and not inside the building may be any color.

- **SHOES:**

- Shoes must adhere securely at the heel and be tied properly if they were designed to do so.
- Flip-flops and heelys are not acceptable.
- Open-toed shoes are acceptable as long as they adhere to the heel.
- On scheduled P.E. days, students are expected to wear tennis shoes to ensure safety.

FRIDAYS:

- Tops can be red, white and blue.
- Background color must be red, white, or navy blue.
- Students are encouraged to wear their spirit shirts (gator), or may wear shirts that have a patriotic theme.
- No collars are required but they must have sleeves.
- **All shirts must be tucked in.**
