#### **Course Description**

This course develops student understanding of proportional relationships, operations with rational numbers, and work with expressions, inequalities, and linear equations. This course improves and extends students' math skills in fundamental processes (with fractions, decimals, and integers), percentages, measurement, and graphing. This course focuses on seventh-grade state standards while moving at an adaptive pace, as outlined in their Individual Education Program (IEP). Students will use the standards for mathematical practice to engage with the subject matter. Students must meet the eligibility criteria to enroll in this class.
