MAT810A Resource Pre-Algebra SY 2023-24



Course Overview

Course Description

This course develops student understanding of irrational numbers, expressions, and equations (including solving linear equations, linear inequalities, and systems of linear equations) and the concept of a function (describing quantitative relationships and modeling an association in bivariate data with a linear equation). Students will continue to explore geometric ideas (Pythagorean theorem, congruence and similarity, and real-world problems involving the volume of cylinders, cones, and spheres), statistics, and probability(patterns in bivariate data and probability models). This course focuses on eighth-grade state standards while moving at an adaptive pace, as outlined in their Individual Education Program (IEP). Students will use the standards for mathematical practice to engage with the subject matter. Students must meet the eligibility criteria to enroll in this class.
